- **Presentation Time:**  
20 minutes for the presentation + 5 minutes for Q&A.  
*A bell will ring at the following intervals:*
  - First bell at 15 minutes
  - Second bell at 20 minutes
  - Third bell at 25 minutes (indicating the end of the Q&A session)
- **Presentation Format:**  
Presentations should utilize slides, videos, or other media.  
On-site presentations will be conducted via Zoom. Please enter the Zoom room before the second previous your presentation and wait your presentation.  
*Make sure to start your presentation by sharing your screen via Zoom.*
- **Copyright and Image Use:**  
Ensure that all images, data, or media in your presentation do not violate copyright or portrait rights.
- **Zoom Connection Check:**  
You can test your Zoom connection in each classroom from 8:45-9:15 or during the lunch and networking period.

### **Notes for Presenters:**

  - The connection method is HDMI. If your device requires an adapter, please bring it with you.
